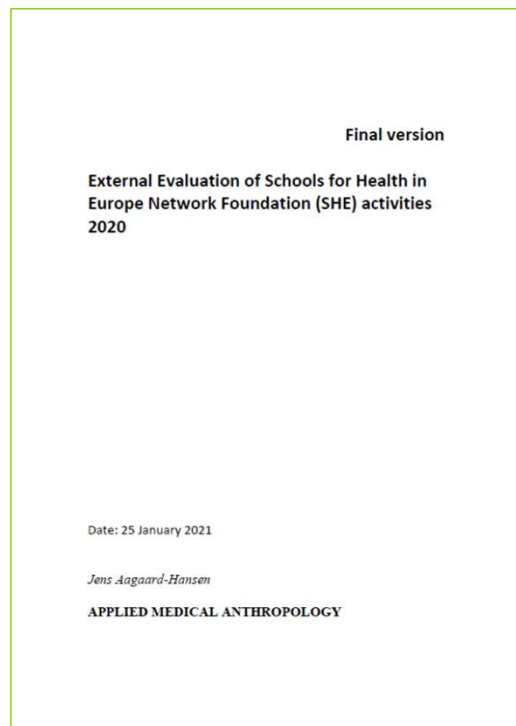

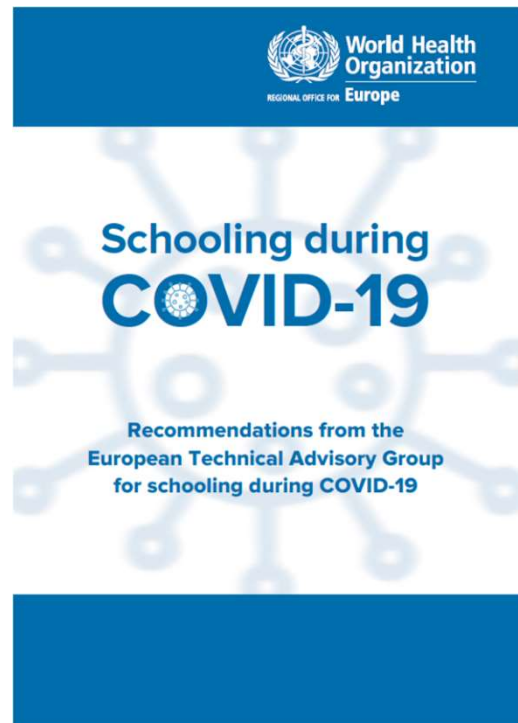
Evaluation 2020



A calculation shows that out of these 16 OOs, 14 have been completely fulfilled (out of which ten are even with over-performance), and a further two were almost fulfilled (Table 4). This is a very impressive result in its own right. However, the performance took place within the context of the rampant pandemic, and consequently the SHE Secretariat and other SHE stakeholders should be highly commended for the flexibility and hard work which allowed them to achieve these results in spite of the challenges.

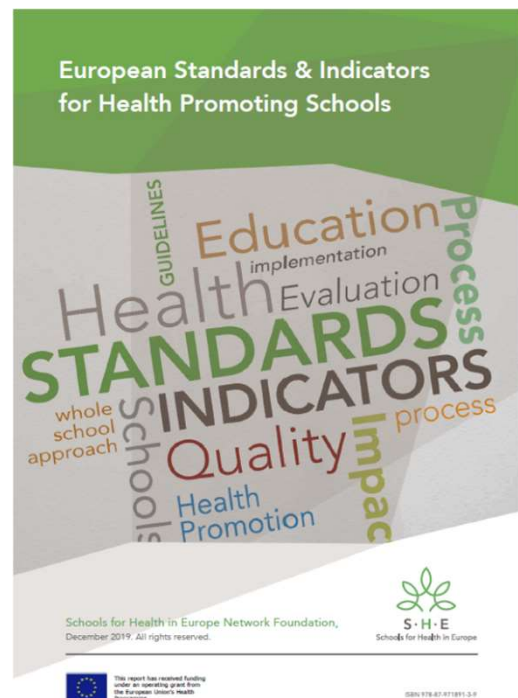

Google Suite

- You now have your own email account within SHE.
- With this follows access to Google Suite – a platform where you can work together.

Dear recipient,

A mailbox has been created for you in the organisation Schools for Health, ending with [@she-research.org](mailto:she-research.org). You should by now have received an email with login information and a one-time password. You are required to set a new password (minimum 8 characters), and to change it every 60 days.

It is recommended to login via a browser the first time.

You can access the mailbox via the web (like Gmail), and you can set it up on your preferred device/smartphone. In most newer smartphones, it is quite easy. You only need to supply the username (the email address) and password.

In some cases it has to be done manually.

First, log in to the mailbox in a browser, and activate the mail. In the settings, look for [Forwarding and POP/IMAP](#) and enable IMAP.
